

Technical Paper #11

Comments on Fluoride and shower filters.

We hope the following comments will be useful to those folks inquiring about fluoride removal.

1. Fluoride is an inorganic salt of fluorine gas and some metal.
2. There is no shower filter regardless of media that can remove or reduce fluoride. Whether it is KDF-55 brass redox media, granular activated carbon, vitamin "C" or anything else a manufacturer can think of using, it will do little or nothing to remove fluoride.
3. Since the vast majority of shower filters use the same KDF-55 technology we pioneered twenty years ago we know we are on very solid ground when we say that KDF-55 atomized brass cannot remove or reduce fluoride, particularly in the small amounts used in a shower filter.
4. If any manufacturer makes the claim that his filter does remove fluoride simply ask him to prove it with third party testing. They will not be able to do it.

We hope this information has proven useful.
